

PUBLIC NOTICE UNDER CLAUSE 5 OF THE FIRST SCHEDULE OF THE RESOURCE MANAGEMENT ACT (1991)

PROPOSED PLAN CHANGE H(b) Notable Trees

Pursuant to Clause 5 of the First Schedule of the Resource Management Act (1991), notice is hereby given of Proposed Plan Change H(b): Notable Trees to the operative Manawatū District Plan.

Intent of Plan Change H(b): Notable Trees

The purpose of Plan Change H(b): Notable Trees [PCH(b)] is to review Appendix 1D – Trees with Heritage Value and corresponding District Plan provisions. A new chapter is proposed to manage notable trees, including an updated notable tree schedule. The scope of PCH(b) is narrow and limited to a review of the existing notable tree schedule only.

PCH(b) proposes the following amendments to the District Plan:

- 1. Removal of Appendix 1D Trees with Heritage Value.
- 2. Remove the notable tree provisions currently in Chapter 4 Historic Heritage.
- 3. Inclusion of a new Notable Tree Chapter including a new Notable Trees Schedule.
- 4. Insert two new definitions in Chapter 2 of the District Plan: "Earthworks" and "Root Protection Area".
- 5. Amend the Planning Maps to identify notable trees with symbols in accordance with the National Planning Standards.
- 6. Remove notable tree symbols on the Planning Maps where the trees are not recommended for protection in the Notable Tree Schedule.
- 7. Amend Chapter 3D Earthworks policy to refer to the Notable Trees Schedule and add a guidance note to refer plan users to the Notable Trees Chapter.
- 8. Amend Rule A1 (land use and subdivision) to update cross references to the Notable Tree Schedule.

Any person may make a submission on PCH(b): Notable Trees to the Operative Manawatū District Plan. Submissions must be in writing in the form prescribed (Form 5) in the Resource Management Act (Forms) Regulations (2003), including submissions via e-mail. Submissions lodged by way of email do not require a signature. The closing date for submissions to PCH(b) is **4pm, Thursday 15 December 2022.**

Certain persons wishing to support or oppose any of these submissions will be entitled to do so. Council will hold a hearing for the Plan Change to consider submissions that have been lodged and issue decisions on the matters raised. Anyone who has made a submission and indicated that they wish to be heard will have the right to attend the hearing and present their submission. On receiving notice of a decision on their submission, any person who disagrees with or is dissatisfied with the decision made may refer the decision to the Environment Court for further consideration.
