TANGIMOANA

GROWING IN FAVOUR.

Boxing Day this year proved a "red letter" day for 'Iangimoana beach when approximately five hundred cars were parked at the water's edge, and three thousand people attended the beach, the majority of whom witnessed a very successful sports gathering organised by the beach committee.

TANGIMOANA BEACH ROAL

PROPOSAL FOR ROAD ACCESS TO OCEAN BEACH.

For some time past Mr. J. Linklater has been interesting himself in an endeavour to have a road put through from Tangimoana settlement giving access to the ocean beach. As a result the Commissioner of Crown Lands has now notified Mr. Linklater that there is a surplus of from two to three hundred pounds over from the settlement roading scheme and if the residents agree to let this amount be expended on the formation of the new road to the occan beach and will indemnify the . Government from any further expenditure in connection with roading at the township, that the Department is prepared to go ahead with the work.

THE BIRTH OF TAHEKE.

Across the river from the wellestablished and thriving riverside settlement of Tangimoana is a stretch of sandy country running to the ocean beach, which it is proposed to convert into the holiday settlement of Taheke. What Tangimoana lacks in the matter of a suitable beach, Taheke possesses and about 100 acres of the country opposite to the present settlement has been set aside by the Government for settlement on similar terms to those which apply to Tangimoana.
