I am writing in response to your official information request dated 10 April 2026 regarding the Scanpower Structure erected on Smith Road, Dannevirke. Your request sought provision of resource consent documentation for the structure. However, there is no resource consent for this work as this is a permitted activity under Rule 5.3.6.2(a) of the Operative District Plan.

The relevant extract from the District Plan is outlined below:

The following activities shall be permitted in all Management Areas, subject to compliance with all relevant environmental standards in Part 5 of this Plan:

- (i) Transformers and lines for conveying electricity at a voltage up to and including 110KV with a design capacity up to and including 100MVA per circuit.
