Tēnā koe,

I'm a producer with TVNZ's in-depth current affairs unit. We're working on a story looking at the government reversing what they call "blanket" speed limits.

Their draft rule states that: *"certain speed limits reduced since 1 January 2020 will be reversed by*

1 July 2025" and all road controlling authorities (RCAs) will need to identify roads in the scope of reversal as soon as practicable.

As an RCA, can you tell me at this stage:

- How many speed limit changes will need to be reversed? [even an approximate number would be really helpful]
- And if possible, an estimated cost to do so?
